Parents will be provided with opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions, share experiences with other parents, and to participate in decisions relating to the education of their children. (Parent-teacher conferences, organization meetings)

Parents will receive a timely response to their suggestions. (phone logs, teacher email, conferences)

The school will coordinate, provide technical assistance, and other support necessary to assist parents in actively participating in the planning and implementing of a parent involvement program. (school support for programs, phone logs, emails, administrative support)

Parent Involvement will be coordinated and integrated with the parent involvement strategies of other programs such as the AVID and Upward Bound. (meeting agendas and sign-in sheets, Site-Based Decision-making Committee meeting)
