Requirements:

- Candidates must have earned the Eagle Scout Award or Girl Scout Gold Award.
- Be a current registered member of an Ennis BSA or Girl Scout Troop.
- Be a graduating high school senior (preference given to EHS seniors).
- Scholarship winner must be enrolled full-time during the 2025 – 2026 academic year at an accredited college/university, trade school or military commitment.

Checklist:

1. Complete application.
2. Include three (3) signed letters of recommendation (excluding relatives):
 - a. One letter from your Scout Leader
 - b. One from your school (teacher, coach, counselor, principal)
 - c. One letter from your pastor/priest/youth minister or community member.
3. Include an acceptance letter from an accredited institution of higher learning, if already accepted.
4. Include a copy of your completed paperwork for Eagle Scout or Girl Scout Gold Award.
5. Attach your resume to this application. List dates for each rank earned as well as all camps attended. Include any awards/recognitions you may have received. List any other organizations, activities, positions held, length of service, awards received or any other information that you would like the Scholarship Committee to consider.
6. Submit a 300-400 word essay describing how your experience in Scouting has impacted your life.
7. Submit the completed application to Mrs. Jaime Regas no later than 1 April 2025.
