Essay Requirement

Include an essay (min. 500 words) responding to at least ONE of the following prompts:

1. **Global Issues and Personal Responsibility**
 - Choose a global issue that resonates with you deeply (such as climate change, human rights, or economic inequality). Describe

how this issue has influenced your worldview and discuss the role you believe individuals or communities can play in addressing it.

2. **Purposeful Living Amidst Life's Unpredictability**

- Share a personal experience where you were confronted with the unpredictability of life. How has this shaped your perspective on living with purpose, facing adversity, and striving for success in your academic and career endeavors?

3. **Real-Life Lessons and Perseverance**

- Discuss real-life lessons that have motivated you to keep striving for a brighter future. How do these experiences reinforce the idea that life is beautiful and that your attitude and actions can shape your reality?

4. **Personal Triumphs in the Face of Adversity**

- Describe a significant challenge or adversity you have faced as a minority student. How did this experience impact your life and shape your approach to achieving your educational and career goals?

5. **Creating a Legacy of Positive Change**

- Think about the legacy you wish to leave in the world. Describe how you envision your future endeavors contributing to this legacy. What kind of impact do you hope to have, and what steps will you take to ensure your actions lead to meaningful change?
