Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

N. Choose One:

1. SFA does or plans to participate in the SFSP [SFA must complete the entire section]
2. SFA does not participate in the SFSP [If this answer is chosen, then Section VI, Subsection N does not apply]

1. SFA shall be responsible for determining the eligibility of all SFSP sites.
2. SFA, as a sponsor, shall be responsible for all management responsibilities of the SFSP, as described in 7 CFR §225.15 (a)(3).
3. Bonding requirements.
 - a. Bid guarantee: Bids that exceed \$50,000 (the State's small purchase threshold) shall include a bid guarantee in the amount of \$ [Enter an amount less than 5% nor more than 10% of the total estimated value of the contract].
Bid guarantees will be returned (a) to unsuccessful Offerors as soon as practicable after the opening of proposals and (b) to the successful Offeror upon execution of such further contractual documents (i.e., insurance coverage) and bonds as may be required by the bid (reference: 7 CFR §225.15(m)(5)).
 - b. Performance bond (required when the value of the Contract exceeds \$50,000, the State's small purchase threshold): Within ten (10) days of the awarding of the contract, the successful Offeror shall provide SFA with a performance bond in the amount of \$ [Enter an amount not less than 10% nor more than 25% of the estimated value of the Contract]. Performance bonds shall be in effect for the life of the Contract or renewed annually (reference: 7 CFR §225.15(m)(6)).
 - c. Bid guarantees and performance bonds must be obtained from a surety company listed in the current U.S. Department of Treasury Circular 570. No alternative forms of bid guarantees or performance bonds are allowed, including but not limited to cash, certified checks, letters of credit, or escrow accounts (reference: 7 CFR §225.15(m)(7)).
