This brochure is designed to assist parents in shopping for school clothes that meet the Ennis ISD Student Standardized Dress Policy.

The color chart contained in this brochure accurately represents the approved uniform colors.

Individual campus principals will be the final authority as to compliance of this dress policy.

*Students who violate the Ennis ISD dress code and require frequent and ongoing correction from the administration will be deemed insubordinate. Consequences for insubordination will be considered serious. Administrative time is very valuable and is best spent working with staff on outstanding curriculum and instructional delivery rather than regularly correcting students about dress code issues.*

All students 4th - 12th grade will wear a face mask or face shield during school hours, with the exception of meals or at the direction of staff due to certain situations. (e.g., meals, playing musical instruments, physical activity)

Masks include non-medical grade disposable face masks, cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth), or full-face shields to protect eyes, nose, and mouth. Face coverings shall be solid maroon, grey, black, white, or light blue and may include a campus or district approved organization, campus or district name or logo, or feature the Lion mascot.

These guidelines are subject to change according to guidance from the Department of State Health Services (DSHS), Ellis County Health Department, and any executive orders or directives from Governor Greg Abbott, to determine the community transmission level and use of face coverings.

## Girls

### TOPS:

- Shirts may be polo style or button up.
- Shirts must be collared and free of any design or logo except approved Ennis Logo
- Shirts must be long enough to cover the stomach and back when arms are raised and when seated.
- Sweatshirts, turtlenecks, and sweaters may be worn if free of any design or logo except approved Ennis logo.
- All tops (including garments worn under or over tops) must be solid white, maroon, navy blue, black or gray.
- Students are allowed to wear maroon, gray, black, or white spirit shirts any day of the week with standardized approved pants/shorts.
- Spirit shirt designs must feature maroon, gray, black, or white colors and include either a campus or district approved organization, the campus or district name, the campus or district logo, or feature the Lion mascot.

### BOTTOMS:

- Pants, shorts, capris, or skirts may be worn.
- Leggings or tights in approved standard dress colors may be worn under pants, shorts, capris, or skirts.
- Shorts at elementary / intermediate schools must have at least a five inch inseam.
- Skirts at elementary / intermediate schools must be at least fingertip length.
- Colors must be solid khaki, black, navy blue, brown, or gray.

### DRESSES:

- Jumpers may be worn with an appropriate top from above.
- Jumpers at elementary / intermediate schools must be fingertip length.
- Colors must be solid khaki, black, navy blue, brown, or gray.

## Boys

### TOPS:

- Shirts may be polo style or button up.
- Shirts must be collared with sleeves and free of any design or logo except approved Ennis logo.
- Sweatshirts, turtlenecks, and sweaters may be worn if free of any design or logo except approved Ennis logo.
- All tops (including garments worn under or over tops) must be solid white, maroon, navy blue, black or gray.
- Students are allowed to wear maroon, gray, black, or white spirit shirts any day of the week with standardized approved pants/shorts.
- Spirit shirt designs must feature maroon, gray, black, or white colors and include either a campus or district approved organization, the campus or district name, the campus or district logo, or feature the Lion mascot.

### BOTTOMS:

- Pants or shorts may be worn.
- All pants or shorts must be solid khaki, black, navy blue, brown, or gray
- Sagging pants or shorts are not permitted.

## Boys & Girls

### SHOES:

- No flip flops (V-strip through toe) may be worn.

### BELTS:

- Optional for grades 1-6.

### JACKETS:

\*\*\*\* If a jacket, sweater, or any other garment is going to be worn all day in the classroom, it must be in one of the approved standard dress colors.

### SPIRIT DAYS:

- Students may wear jeans with a regular dress code shirt or an Ennis Spirit T-shirt. Jeans must be neatly hemmed, have no holes, and be free of design, logos, or embroidery.

All clothes must fit appropriately and be worn with appropriate undergarments as deemed fit by the campus administration. Campus administration will have complete and final judgment on all matters concerning interpretation of the student dress code.
